## Immigration in New Jersey

### Immigration by the Numbers

Population (2011 Census Bureau estimate)	8,821,155
Illegal Alien Population (2010 FAIR estimate)	410,000
Illegal Alien Share (2009 FAIR estimate)	4.6%
Cost of Illegal Aliens (2010 FAIR estimate)	\$3,478,000,000
Projected Population 2050 (2006 FAIR estimate)	13,895,800
Unemployment Rate (BLS estimate, Oct 2012)	9.7%

### Cost to New Jerseyans

\$3.48 billion a year spent on illegal immigration

- \$2.44 billion a year to educate the children of illegal aliens
- \$509 million a year on unreimbursed health care for illegal aliens
- \$336 million a year on criminal justice activities for illegal aliens
- \$69.7 million a year on welfare for illegal aliens
- \$125 million a year for additional state/local operating costs
- \$1,327 annual cost to each of New Jersey's native-born headed households
