FAIR's Congressional Voting Report is designed to help you understand the positions that each U.S. Representative has taken on immigration measures during the 114th Congress in furtherance of a rational immigration system. Despite controlling both houses of Congress, House Republican leaders showed little desire to pursue true immigration reforms or rein in the Obama administration's abuse of executive power. Nevertheless, we have chosen several immigration-related votes to present a picture of each Representative's position. Where a Representative voted with FAIR's position on an amendment or bill, you will see a green plus sign (+). Where a Representative voted against FAIR's position, you will see a red minus sign (-). Where a Representative voted "present," you will see (P). Where a Representative did not vote, you will see (NV). During any period that a Representative was not present in office, you will see (NP).

FIRST SESSION, January to December 2015

H.R. 240

Department of Homeland Security Appropriations Act

H.R. 240 was the 2015 fiscal year funding bill through which Congress appropriated money to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and its agencies, including Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS), and Customs and Border Protection (CBP). Funding is used to pay for the salaries and expenses of all DHS employees, as well as all programs implemented by the department. **Below is a listing of the key amendments FAIR supported or opposed that did receive a roll call vote:**

House Vote 29, Executive Amnesty | January 14, 2015—Rep. Robert Aderholt (R-AL) amendment H.Amdt. 6 to defund President Obama's November 2014 executive amnesty (Johnson Memos) as well as his 2011 amnesty (Morton Memos). The amendment also prohibits DHS funds or fees from being used to grant any Federal benefit to amnestied illegal aliens. The amendment was agreed to 237-190. **FAIR supported H.Amdt. 6.**

House Vote 30, Executive Amnesty | January 14, 2015—Rep. Marsha Blackburn (R-TN) amendment H.Amdt. 7 to defund President Obama's Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) amnesty program. The amendment was agreed to 218-209. **FAIR supported H.Amdt. 7.**

H.R. 1735

National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA)

H.R. 1735 was the 2016 fiscal year funding bill through which Congress appropriated money for military activities of the Department of Defense (DOD), for military construction, and for defense activities of the Department of Energy (DOE), to prescribe military personnel strengths for the fiscal

year, and for other purposes. **Below is a listing of the key amendments FAIR supported or opposed that did receive a roll call vote:**

House Vote 229, Amnesty | May 29, 2015—Rep. Mo Brooks (R-AL) amendment H.Amdt. 219 to remove language from the NDAA that instructs the Defense Secretary to consider Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) recipients “vital to the national interest” and thus eligible to enlist in the military. The amendment was agreed to 221-202. **FAIR supported H.Amdt. 219.**

H.R. 2578
Commerce, Justice, Science Appropriations Act

H.R. 2578 was the 2016 fiscal year funding bill through which Congress appropriated money to the Departments of Commerce, Justice, and Science (CJS), including provisions that increase immigration enforcement. Specifically, the CJS bill increased funding for the State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP) by \$10 million. SCAAP funding reimburses states and municipalities for costs incurred from the incarceration of criminal aliens. The CJS bill also allocated \$422 million to the Justice Department’s (DOJ) Executive Office of Immigration Review—a \$75 million increase in order to fund 55 additional immigration judges. **Below is a listing of the key amendments FAIR supported or opposed that did receive a roll call vote:**

House Vote 293, Executive Amnesty | June 3, 2015—Rep. Steve King (R-IA) amendment H.Amdt. 350 to prohibit the use of funds to defend the 26 state lawsuit challenging the legality of President Obama’s executive amnesty programs. The amendment was agreed to 222-204. **FAIR supported H.Amdt. 350.**

House Vote 294, Interior Enforcement | June 3, 2015— Rep. Steve King (R-IA) amendment H.Amdt. 352 to prohibit the DOJ’s State and Local Grant funding from being used in contravention of the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996 (relating to establishment of sanctuary cities). The amendment was agreed to 227-198. **FAIR supported H.Amdt. 352.**

H.R. 2577
Transportation, Housing and Urban Development, and Related Agencies
Appropriations Act

H.R. 2577 was the 2016 fiscal year funding bill through which Congress appropriated money to the Department of Transportation (DOT), the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), and several related agencies. **Below is a listing of the key amendments FAIR supported or opposed that did receive a roll call vote:**

House Vote 319, Interior Enforcement | June 9, 2015—Rep. Ted Yoho (R-FL) amendment H.Amdt. 420 to prohibit the use of funds in contravention of current law which prevents illegal aliens from obtaining housing assistance. The amendment was agreed to 244-181. **FAIR supported H.Amdt. 420.**

H.R. 3009
Enforce the Law for Sanctuary Cities Act

House Vote 466, Interior Enforcement | July 23, 2015—In response to the murder of Kate Steinle, the House considered legislation to target sanctuary cities—State and local jurisdictions with policies that obstruct immigration enforcement. H.R. 3009, introduced by Rep. Duncan Hunter (R-CA), denies certain federal funds to sanctuary cities. Specifically, the bill denies SCAAP funds, and COPS and Byrne grants to States and jurisdictions that refuse to share with the federal government the immigration status of individuals in violation of current law or have a policy in place that prohibits the collection of this information. The bill passed 241-179. **FAIR supported H.R. 3009.**
