1. Many inmates in local jails are also deportable illegal aliens. Because of that, U.S. immigration officials often ask jails to hold these individuals so the federal government can take custody when their sentences are done. Some jails comply with those requests; some don't and simply release the criminal alien back into the local community.   
A bill called the No Sanctuary for Criminals Act clarifies the law so that police and sheriffs who run the local jails will know they can and should comply with these requests. The bill has already passed in the House of Representatives, and is awaiting a Senate vote. Do you support or oppose this part of the No Sanctuary for Criminals Act?
