FAIR's Congressional Voting Report is designed to help you understand a U.S. representative's support for immigration measures to strengthen or weaken immigration control during the second session of the 108th Congress. We have chosen ten key votes, cosponsorship on five immigration-related bills, and membership in the House Immigration Reform Caucus as the benchmarks for assessing stances. Where a member voted in line with FAIR's recommendations or cosponsored a bill that FAIR supports, you will see a plus sign (+). Where a member voted against FAIR's recommendations or supported a bill that FAIR opposed, you will see a minus sign (-). Membership in the House Immigration Reform Caucus is indicated by a plus (+).

- EXPLANATION OF BILLS -

House Vote Number 182 H.R. 3722—Undocumented Alien Emergency Medical Assistance Amendments Sponsor: Rep. Dana Rohrabacher (R-CA)

FAIR fully supported H.R. 3722, which would prohibit federal reimbursement of hospital-provided emergency and certain transportation services to illegal aliens unless the hospital provides the Secretary of Homeland Security with information regarding an alien's citizenship, immigration status, financial data, and employer. The bill would make those who knowingly hire illegal aliens responsible for health care costs incurred, and directs the Secretary to initiate removal procedures against aliens determined to be removable under federal immigration law.

If the member voted with FAIR for H.R. 3722, you'll see a plus sign (+). If the member voted against H.R. 3722, you'll see a minus sign (-). Unfortunately, H.R. 3722 was defeated on May 18, 2004 by a vote of 88-331, with 14 House members not voting.

House Vote Number 196
H.AMDT.532—Troops on the Border Amendment
Sponsor: Rep. Virgil Goode Jr. (R-VA)

FAIR fully supported the Goode amendment to the National Defense Authorization bill. The "Troops on the Border" amendment would authorize the U.S. Secretary of Defense to assign members of the Army, Navy, Air Force, and Marine Corps to assist the Department of Homeland Security in the performance of border protection functions. The troops would be authorized to assist the Bureau of Border Security in preventing the entry of terrorists, drug traffickers and illegal aliens into the United States.

A vote for the Goode amendment indicates the member recognizes the need to better control our border. The "Troops on the Border" amendment would have greatly aided our outnumbered border patrol by reducing the opportunity for terrorists and illegal aliens to sneak into the country. If the member voted with FAIR for the amendment, you'll see a plus sign (+). If the member voted against the amendment, you'll see a minus sign (-). The amendment passed on May 19, 2004 by a vote of 231-191, with 11 House members not voting, but was later stripped out during House-Senate conference.

House Vote Number 270 H.AMDT.583—Sanctuary Amendment Sponsor: Rep. Tom Tancredo (R-CO)

FAIR fully supported the Tancredo amendment to the appropriations bill for the Department of Homeland Security. The amendment would prohibit Department of Homeland Security funds from being allocated to states or localities that refuse to share information with the Bureau of Immigration and Customs regarding an individual's citizenship or immigration status as required by a 1996 law. The amendment was prompted by actions increasingly taken by cities and local jurisdictions adopting non-cooperation ordinances banning local enforcement officials from sharing information with federal immigration authorities.

A vote for the Tancredo amendment indicates the member supports efforts to prevent states and localities from adopting non-cooperation laws that offer illegal aliens safe harbor. If the member voted with FAIR for the amendment, you'll see a plus sign (+). If the member voted against the amendment, you'll see a minus sign (-). Unfortunately, the amendment was defeated on June 18, 2004 by a vote of 148-259, with 26 House members not voting.

House Vote Number 341 H.AMDT.655—Sanctuary Amendment Sponsor: Rep. Steve King (R-IA)

FAIR fully supported the King amendment to the appropriations bill for the Departments of Commerce, Justice, State, and Related Agencies. The amendment sought to provide \$1 million for the Department of Justice to enforce a section of the 1996 law which forbids localities from preventing their police officers from reporting immigration information to federal immigration authorities.

A vote for the King amendment indicates the member supports efforts to prevent states and localities from adopting non-cooperation laws that offer illegal aliens safe harbor. If the member voted with FAIR for the amendment, you'll see a plus sign (+). If the member voted against the amendment, you'll see a minus sign (-). Unfortunately, the amendment was defeated on July 8, 2004 by a vote of 139-278, with 66 House members not voting.

House Vote Number 439 H.AMDT.745—Social Security Amendment Sponsor: Rep. J.D. Hayworth (R-AZ)

FAIR fully supported the Hayworth amendment to the appropriations bill for the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education, and Related Agencies. The amendment sought to block payments of benefits under the proposed Social Security totalization agreement that was signed with Mexico.

A vote for the Hayworth amendment indicates the member recognizes that fraud by illegal aliens and the possibility of future amnesties makes this agreement with Mexico a major threat to the solvency of the Social Security trust fund. If the member voted with FAIR for the amendment, you'll see a plus sign (+). If the member voted against the amendment, you'll see a minus sign (-). Unfortunately, the amendment was defeated on September 9, 2004 by a vote of 178-225, with 30 House members not voting.

House Vote Number 452 H.AMDT.754—Matricula Consular Amendment Sponsor: Rep. Michael Oxley (R-OH)

FAIR opposed the Oxley amendment to the appropriations bill for the Departments of Transportation, Treasury, and Independent Agencies. The amendment deleted a section of the bill that would have prohibited the Secretary of the Treasury from using appropriated funds to publish, implement, administer, or enforce regulations that permit financial institutions to accept the matricula consular identification card as a form of identification.

A vote for the Oxley amendment indicates a member puts banking interests ahead of homeland security by allowing banks and other financial institutions to accept the Mexican matricula consular document in lieu of valid U.S.-issued identity documents. The FBI and the Department of Justice say that matricula consular cards are not a reliable form of identification and pose "major criminal threats" and a "potential terrorist threat." In addition, they are only needed by illegal aliens because legal residents can use other documents to identify themselves.

If the member voted with FAIR against the amendment, you'll see a plus sign (+). If the member voted against FAIR for the amendment, you'll see a minus sign (-). On September 14, 2004, the House approved the amendment by a vote of 222-177, with 34 House members not voting.

House Vote Number 510

H.AMDT.785—Substitute Amendment to H.R. 10 to Implement 9/11 Commission Recommendations Sponsor: Rep. Robert Menendez (D-NJ)

FAIR opposed the Menendez substitute amendment to the 9/11 Recommendations Implementation Act. The Menendez substitute amendment would effectively strip out all of the identification security and immigration enforcement provisions in the House bill to implement the 9/11 Commission recommendations.

A vote for the Menendez amendment indicates the member opposes the 9/11 Commission's immigration-related recommendations. If the member voted with FAIR against the amendment, you'll see a plus sign (+). If the member voted against FAIR for the amendment, you'll see a minus sign (-). Fortunately, the amendment was defeated on October 8, 2004 by a vote of 203-213, with 17 House members not voting.

House Vote Number 518

H.AMDT.798—Amendment #15 to Strike Asylum Reforms from H.R. 10 to Implement the 9/11 Commission Recommendations

Sponsor: Rep. Chris Smith (R-NJ)

FAIR opposed Smith Amendment #15 to the 9/11 Recommendations Implementation Act. The amendment would strip from the bill much needed asylum and refugee reforms.

If the member voted with FAIR against the amendment, you'll see a plus sign (+). If the member voted against FAIR for the amendment, you'll see a minus sign (-). Fortunately, the amendment was defeated on October 8, 2004 by a vote of 197-219, with 16 House members not voting.

House Vote Number 521

H.AMDT.798—Amendment #14 to Strike Expedited Removal from H.R. 10 to Implement the 9/11 Commission Recommendations

Sponsor: Rep. Chris Smith (R-NJ)

FAIR opposed Smith Amendment #14 to the 9/11 Recommendations Implementation Act. The amendment would remove provisions in the bill allowing expedited removal of illegal aliens present in the country for five years or less.

If the member voted with FAIR against the amendment, you'll see a plus sign (+). If the member voted against FAIR for the amendment, you'll see a minus sign (-). Fortunately, the amendment was defeated on October 8, 2004 by a vote of 203-210, with 19 House members not voting.

House Vote Number 523

H.R. 10—9/11 Recommendations Implementation Act

Sponsor: Rep. Dennis Hastert (R-IL)

FAIR fully supported H.R. 10, a serious 9/11 Commission national security bill that includes a wide range of long-overdue changes to how U.S. documents are issued, and finally moves the country toward border security and a serious immigration enforcement and control regimen.

If the member voted with FAIR for H.R. 10, you'll see a plus sign (+). If the member voted against H.R. 10, you'll see a minus sign (-). H.R. 10 was approved on October 8, 2004 by a vote of 282-132, with 17 House members not voting. H.R. 10 has 26 cosponsors in addition to the original bill sponsor and currently faces a House-Senate conference.

H.R. 687—The Identification Integrity Act of 2003 Sponsor: Rep. Elton Gallegly (R-CA)

FAIR supported H.R. 687, which would bar acceptance by the federal government of unverifiable consular identification cards issued by foreign governments. The growing acceptance of foreign government-issued identity cards, such as the Mexican matricula consular card, is of concern because they are non-verifiable, used primarily by illegal aliens, and pose "major criminal threats," according to the FBI and Department of Justice. Members who cosponsored the legislation have plus signs (+) in this column. H.R. 687 has 131 cosponsors in addition to the original bill sponsor. No votes have been taken on the bill. A similar bar on the acceptance of consular ID cards was included in H.R. 10, the 9/11 Recommendations Implementation Act.

H.R. 775—Security and Fairness Enhancement for America Act of 2003 Sponsor: Rep. Bob Goodlatte (R-VA)

FAIR supported H.R. 775, which would eliminate the much abused diversity visa lottery program. The removal of this controversial program will help ensure our nation's security, make the administration of our immigration laws more consistent and fair, and help reduce immigration fraud. Members who cosponsored the legislation have plus signs (+) in this column. H.R. 775 has 55 cosponsors in addition to the original bill sponsor. H.R. 775 was approved by the House Judiciary Committee on September 30, 2004, but was never considered by the full House.

H.R. 1684—The Student Adjustment Act of 2003 Sponsor: Rep. Chris Cannon (R-UT)

FAIR opposed H.R. 1684, which would allow illegal aliens to attend state universities at in-state tuition rates, while unfairly denying those benefits to U.S. citizens and legal immigrants from other states. The bill would also grant amnesty to illegal aliens under the age of 21 who have been in the United States for five consecutive years. Members who cosponsored this amnesty bill have minus signs (-) in this column. H.R. 1684 has 148 cosponsors in addition to the original bill sponsor. No votes were taken on the bill.

H.R. 2671—The Clear Law Enforcement for Criminal Alien Removal Act of 2003 Sponsor: Rep. Charlie Norwood (R-GA)

FAIR supported H.R. 2671, which would give state and local law enforcement agencies the authority and resources needed to detain criminal illegal aliens within the course of their regular duties. It would also create a new grant program for the purchase of equipment for housing and processing illegal aliens. Members who cosponsored the legislation have plus signs (+) in this column. H.R. 2671 has 122 cosponsors in addition to the original bill sponsor. The House Subcommittee on Immigration, Border Security, and Claims held a hearing on the H.R. 2671 on October 1, 2003, but no votes were taken on the bill.

H.R. 3142—Agricultural Job Opportunity, Benefits, and Security Act of 2003 (AgJOBS) Sponsor: Rep. Chris Cannon (R-UT)

FAIR opposed H.R. 3142 which would provide a "one-time" amnesty for illegal aliens engaged in farm work and their spouses and children. The bill would also expand the H-2A agricultural guestworker program. Members who cosponsored this amnesty bill have minus signs (-) in this column. H.R. 3142 has 121 cosponsors in addition to the original bill sponsor. No votes were taken on the bill.

Congressional Immigration Reform Caucus

Members of the Immigration Reform Caucus have plus signs (+) for their dedication to reforming our immigration laws to serve the interests of Americans and preserve the rule of law. The Immigration Reform Caucus currently has 71 committed House members.
